Services Description

<p>Airspace Monitoring Service</p>	<p>Airspace Monitoring Service typically of a company pre-installing Counter-UAS detection equipment within a specific area, such as a large metropolitan city. The service provider may have a cloud-based solution which the subscriber accesses for real-time monitoring of the airspace of interest.</p>
<p>Conferences and Events</p>	<p>Companies that plan and host Counter-UAS industry-related conferences and events. Events may include tabletop exercises and exercise planning.</p>
<p>Counter-UAS as a Service (CaaS)</p>	<p>Counter-UAS as a Service (CaaS) refers to companies that provide Counter-UAS technology and operational personnel to provide airspace awareness and security coverage at a venue, facility, or other protected asset.</p>
<p>Counter-UAS Consulting</p>	<p>Companies that provide Counter-UAS consulting services to industry product and service providers, as well as end-user customers.</p>
<p>Counter-UAS Training</p>	<p>Companies that provide Counter-UAS related training for military, public safety, and critical infrastructure.</p>
<p>Degree and Certificate Programs</p>	<p>Accredited academic institutions that provide UAS and Counter-UAS-related degree and certificate programs, both online and in-person.</p>
<p>Drone Forensics</p>	<p>Companies that provide drone forensics services, which includes the forensic processing, examination, and analysis of uncrewed aircraft systems (UAS).</p>
<p>Open Source Intelligence (OSINT)</p>	<p>Open source intelligence (OSINT) is the act of gathering and analyzing publicly available data for intelligence purposes and providing compiled information and analysis as a service.</p>
<p>Professional Services</p>	<p>Companies that provide professional services, such as contract personnel to Counter-UAS product and service suppliers. Professional services may include both technical and non-technical professional services. Many companies provide personnel with specific UAS and Counter-UAS technical expertise. Examples include intelligence analysts, field service support representatives, legal support, electronic warfare specialists, electrical engineers, operations analysts, and systems integrators.</p>
<p>Red Team</p>	<p>Red Team is a professional service that includes the use of multi-rotor and fixed-wing UAS to provide support to training, testing, demonstrations, and assessments of Counter-UAS technologies.</p>

Services Description

Testing	Companies that provide specialized Research, Development, Testing, and Evaluation (RDT&E) of Counter-UAS and UAS technologies and services.
Training and Testing Locations	Training and testing locations where UAS and Counter-UAS-related companies can use their products or services.
UAS Consulting	Companies that provide UAS consulting services to industry product and service providers, as well as end-user customers.
UAS Training	Companies that provide UAS related training for military, public safety, and critical infrastructure. Training topics may include UAS skills, UAS equipment, UAS operations, and legal considerations.
